



CSEG Foundation Learning Funding Opportunities

Purpose:

The *CSEG Foundation* in conjunction with the *Outreach and Educational Services Committees* will assist members by financially supporting organized educational opportunities to develop their professional knowledge, skill foundations and attributes as geoscientists. Cost can be a deterrent, sometimes even preventing participating in educational opportunities and thereby preventing various important learning opportunities.

Activities that fulfill the following criteria will be considered:

- Programs supporting education in geophysics and the earth sciences;
- Post secondary education in geophysics and the earth sciences, including the establishment and continuation of the Canadian Society of Exploration Geophysicists scholarship programs;
- Continuing education of geophysicists through the development of courses relating to developing technology, publications relating to the geosciences and by establishing education programs;
- Scientific activities by providing funding of academic research programs;
- Non-profit programs designed to further the development of geophysical techniques aimed at improvements in geophysical applications in the earth sciences;
- The preservation of the history of geophysical exploration;
- The business application of geophysics as defined in the mandate of the Canadian Society of Exploration Geophysicists;
- Efforts to solicit and receive donations, bequests, legacies and grants, awards and to enter into agreements, contracts and undertakings which promote the above

Application Forms are to be presented to CSEG Foundation or Outreach Committee. Each application should include the following minimum requirements:

- The name of the organization/ individuals applying (must be CSEG members/ involved in Canadian Geosciences).
- The proposed activity to be funded and an explanation of this will directly relate to the development of their geophysical knowledge, skills and attributes.
- A letter of endorsement from a credible source
- Article in the Recorder (at the conclusion of the activity)
- Applications must be for non-profit ventures only
- Funding proposals will be reviewed on a bi-annual basis. Requests must be received before the 15th of June and December annually

“Applications will be determined on a case-by-case basis. Subsidies can change year-to-year, based upon the number of applicants. In the event of more applications than funds available, a method will be established (and published) to allow the committee to choose appropriate applicants. Funding may not be given if it specifically overlaps other CSEG/ SEG subsidies”
