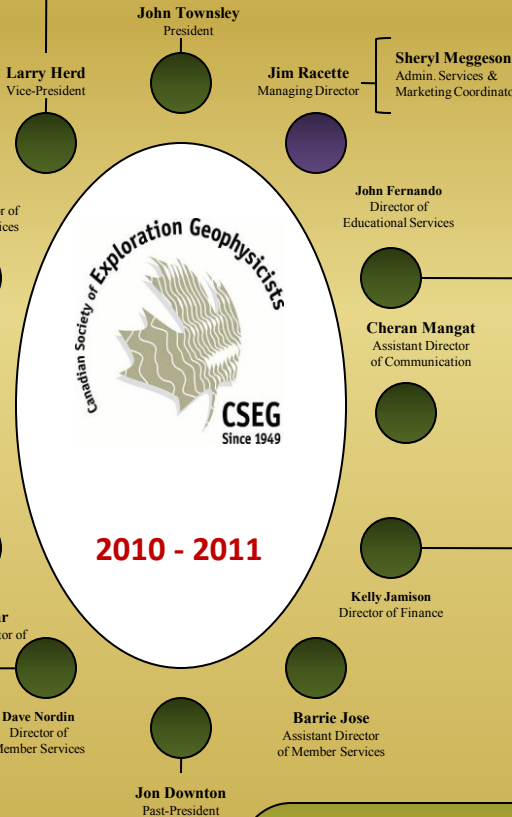
**T-Wave Golf Tournament**
