Then enter the first annual **CSEG Challenge Bowl** on Wednesday, May 16, 2007 at 4:00 PM at the Calgary Marriott Hotel. The Challenge Bowl will take place during the Student/Industry Reception at the 2007 CSPG CSEG Convention and is a chance for university students to display their geophysical and geological knowledge.

We invite teams of two students (graduate or undergraduate) from any university or college in Canada to enter the Challenge Bowl to compete against pairs of students from other universities or colleges.

The format will consist of single and multiple-choice questions from a range of geophysical (and geological) topics.

10 students are eligible for a **\$100 travel grant** from the CSEG to attend the annual conference in Calgary.
