



CSEG Student Travel Bursary:

To provide financial support to geophysical students who plan to attend the CSEG/ CSPG convention:

Purpose:

The CSEG/ CSPG convention is the largest gathering of geo-scientists in Canada. Due to the fact that the convention is always held in Calgary, many participants need to travel great distances. Participating in this conference can be an invaluable experience to those that attend. At the convention, students will have the opportunity to develop their professional knowledge, skills and attributes, present papers, compete in the challenge bowl, network with other geo-scientists and learn. The cost of CSEG/CSPG convention can be prohibitive for students especially if the student has to travel to Calgary in order to attend. As a result, the cost can be a deterrent, or in some cases may even prevent individuals from attending and therefore miss a great learning opportunity.

The CSEG Outreach committee proposes that the CSEG as a whole provide financial support to its up and coming members.

Suggested Criteria:

- The individual must be a member of the CSEG
- Preference will be given to students who can show financial need
- The individual must be pursuing a degree in the geosciences, preferably geophysics
- Preference will be given to students who are either presenting a paper, volunteering, or competing in the challenge bowl
- Students will pay for their costs upfront and then submit their receipts at the commencement of the conference
- Costs covered will be limited to travel expenses only
- The student must demonstrate good academic standing
- The application process will begin six months before the convention with the deadline for applying occurring one month prior to commencement
